

Final Group Project- 200 points

The point values listed are the highest number of points available to you. Simply completing the assignment will earn you SOME of the points. Completing the assignment at an excellent level will earn you ALL of them.

GROUP GRADE- 75 pts

Presented Scene- Production/ Design/ Direction/ Script/ Spectacle.

20 pts

Presented as a group during last class. All members in the group must contribute to the final performance in some way. Presentations must be between **8 and 12 minutes**.

Final Show Binder - Clean/ Neat/ Labeled.

20pts

Include at minimum:

Copy of Script, copy of publicity poster, copy of program, photo of diorama, and all of the group members' individual grade paperwork neatly organized with group work in front, individual work in back.

Extras to include:

Costume renderings, character analyses, props lists, rehearsal notes, blocking notes, class work etc. - all highly encouraged.

Due on final day of all group presentations.

Completed Model- Quality/ Neatness/Appropriateness/ Creativity.

15pts

A box representation of what your set would look like if you had the resources to build a fully realized set. Remember- this is a tool to help the director and actors know what it WOULD look like if you COULD build it. Be true to the work the actors and directors are doing- we should see how the space works with the imagined scenery.

Physical model to be on display on date of performance.

Photo of model must be included in final show binder.

Publicity Poster- Interesting/ Informative

10pts

A 1 page poster promoting your show. What, when and where? Presented by? Imagery? Suitable for all ages? Use the publicity posters you see around campus as a guide. Be sure it is something that can be copied and distributed (think "can I photocopy this?")

Hard copy to be on display on date of performance.

Copy must be included in final show binder.

Program- Clarity/ Thoroughness/ Extras.

10pts

The program must list all group members and their positions. You should include extras such as directors notes, dramaturgical notes, and/or 'sponsors/ads'. Please look at and read (maybe even save for reference) the programs you receive at your performances. There are some distinct style choices that are made in programs (for example: how to write a bio).

Hard copy to be on display on date of performance.

Copy must be included in final show binder.

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INDIVIDUAL GRADE- 125 pts

All individual work is due on the final day of group presentations in your group's final show binder.

Reflection Paper- Articulation of thought/ / Value Recognition/ Detailed 60 pts

A detailed description of process, and an explanation of what it is that you learned/ gained from this experience (or didn't).

Please write your reflection paper before your present. After you have presented, I'll ask you to write-in 10 sentences by hand at the end of your reflection paper about the final product: your 'end of project' thoughts etc.

Due on final day of group presentations in final show binder.

Individual Contribution- Your contribution and value to group 30 pts

Tell me what contributions you made to the group, detailing why they were essential for this collaboration. Things that you might see as small (like attending every rehearsal on time and prepared) are big contributions. This is your time to show me all the work you did that I couldn't see. Bullet points are fine.

Due on final day of group presentations in final show binder.

Support of Contribution- Recognition of work contributed by others 20pts

Tell me all of the contributions from each member of your group, **and** how you feel about their contributions. This is your time to give credit to or highlight inconsistencies of other group members during this process that I couldn't see. Bullet points are fine.

Due on final day of group presentations in final show binder.

Assessment of Other Groups- Appropriate, objective, and honest evaluation 15pts

Complete the group assessment sheet that will be provided for you honestly and appropriately. Your grade will be based on how accurately you asses each group, and will be compared to your classmates assessments as well as my own for accuracy and objectivity.

Due on final day of group presentations in final show binder.

**For Individual work, it has worked best in the past if all group members bring their individual work, printed out and hole punched, to the final performance. There will be time at the end of all of the performances for groups to finalize binders, look at the design work of other groups, complete their Assessments of Other Groups paperwork, and say goodbye to this class.*

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
